With reference to your letter of the 6th Inst. respecting the case of the Steamer "Strathclyde", I have again had an interview with the Owners who state that when I saw them in May last they hoped that the vessel, which was on a time charter, would have been re-delivered to them last month, but Messrs Barber & Co., of New York, to whom the vessel is chartered, took advantage of an alternative in charter party to retain vessel for another six months.

Under these circumstances the Owners hope the Committee will allow them to postpone the Special Runway R² 2 until the re-delivery of the vessel, in the United States, on the 5th Dec^r next when they will arrange
