I have to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a letter from the owners of the steamer "STRATHLEVEN", No.1155 in the Register book, in which it is stated that arrangements have been made for the special Survey No.2 to be completed at your port, where the vessel will be about Monday of next week.

I have therefore to acquaint you that to complete the survey in question all the requirements of the rules for the survey of the hull of the vessel remain to be complied with except the examination of the bottom in dry dock; & the inspection of the fore peak and gun decks. The Survey of the boilers and machinery has been held; &, on the occasion of the completion of the same in London on February last, the 5th length of tunnel shafting which was found flawed, was recommended to be again examined before the end of February last.

I have therefore to request that you will give the case the necessary attention on the vessel's arrival.
