VESSEL'S NAME *Iron Sc 3 Met Sr. Strathleven* Report *Inst. No. 1358*

Nature of Survey *S.S. No 2. advanced*

The S.S.No.2, due 10.97, was partly held at Barry in November 1897 at St. John's, N.W.I. ^{and} in September ~~at~~ London in November last.

The Marseilles Surveyor now reports that the survey has been further advanced by examination of Nos.2 & 3 holds. The ceiling in No.3 hold was found to be defective in places, and the wood bulkhead of Officers' quarters found temporarily repaired having been damaged during heavy weather.

It is proposed to effect the necessary repairs, and to complete the S.S.No.2 at Genoa, to which port the vessel has proceeded.

It is submitted the Genoa Surveyor be advised, and further action deferred until receipt of his report.
