classing letter of yesterday, respecting the case  
of the steamer "Strathleven", my report no.  
724, I respectfully beg to state that, in  
my opinion, the 5<sup>th</sup> length of tunnel  
shafting should be again submitted for  
examination within about three months'  
time from last survey, if then the flaw  
be found in same state it would be safe  
to have a further survey six months later,  
before the limit on this shaft may be  
removed.
