The S.S. No. 1 was held at Hull in September, 1894, and the notation assigned, subject to the deck, which was worn thin, being renewed within 9 months from that date.

The case received the consideration of the Committee on the 6th. March last, and was deferred for a month, to enable the new decks to be laid, the material for which it was stated had been ordered.

In reply to enquiry the Hull Surveyors now state that ~~the~~ case is expected to be attended to about the 14th. May next.

It is submitted the Hull Surveyors should be requested to ascertain from the Owners ~~definitely~~ when they propose to renew the ~~deck~~ deck. In the meantime the class might be allowed to remain undisturbed
