The S.S. No 1 was held at Hull in September 1894 and the notation assigned, subject to the deck which was worn thin, being renewed within 9 months from that date.


In August last the Hull Surveyors reported that they had examined the deck in question, which was sheathed all over, and satisfactory for present use.

The Owners proposal to renew the deck in 6 months was approved 27/8/95.

In reply to inquiry the Hull Surveyors now state that the material for the deck of this vessel is ordered and will be fitted as soon as possible.

It is submitted that action on this case should be deferred for a month to enable the new deck to be laid.
