Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of Mr. Scullard's letter of the 15th instant respecting the Motor Vessel "LIZZIE & ANNIE", from which it is noted that the Owners have withdrawn their application for the re-classification of this vessel in the Society's Register Book.

The Committee will, however, be prepared to assign a freeboard as for an unclassified vessel for a period of four years, and the freeboard certificates forwarded to you on the 25th ultimo should therefore be returned to this Office for cancellation, upon which fresh certificates on the form for unclassified vessels will be issued.

As regards the fees to be charged in this case the amounts suggested by you, viz:- £12 for the Hull Survey and £10 for the Machinery are approved, and you should render an account to the Owners accordingly. I should add that the Rule fee for freeboard assignment as an unclassified vessel in this case is £6, but provided the above mentioned fees, amounting to £22, be paid, no additional charge on this account should be made.
