With reference to your letter of the 12th inst, regarding re-classification of the Motor vessel "LIZZIE & ANNIE" Hull No. 33361. I beg to state that I have been informed by owners representative that they desire their application to this vessel be withdrawn, as it is not their intention to have the separate power pump required by the Committee. As the Owners do not desire this vessel to be classed I shall be pleased to be informed what action should be taken regarding the freeboard. The freeboard certificates have been handed to the Owners, as all the requirements for freeboard have been complied with. It is assumed the freeboard assigned as an unclassified vessel will be the same as at present, but that new certificates be issued and the present certificates cancelled.
