With reference to your letter of the 8th instant regarding the machinery Survey due upon the M.V. "LIZZIE & ANNIE", we are now informed that the Owners have decided to fit a new engine in this vessel early next month.

We are informed that the proposed engine was built in February 1932 by A/B Svenska Maskinverken, Sodertalje, and is numbered 2114/6934, but we cannot find out whether it has been built under Special Survey or not.
