I am in receipt of your letter of the 5th instant respecting the starting air receiver proposed to be fitted in the m.v. "LIZZIE & ANNIE", and which does not comply with the requirements of the Society's Rules.

I have to point out that Section 6, Clause 3 of the Rules for Heavy Oil Engines requires that in the case of welded air receivers, the welding is to be lap-welding; neither oxy-acetylene nor electric welding will be permitted, and, in the circumstances, I wired you today, as below, intimating that the air receiver in question cannot be accepted and should not be used.
