I am in receipt of your letter of the 13th instant enclosing plan of riveted steel air receiver proposed by Messrs. Amos & Smith Ltd., for the m.v. "LIZZIE & ANNIE", and with regard thereto, I have to acquaint you that this plan will be approved, for a working pressure of 260 lb. per sq. inch, provided the thickness of the cover plate be not less than $1\frac{1}{32}$ " and the receiver be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing, and to your entire satisfaction.

It is concluded that the thickness of the dished end plate is the same as that of the cylindrical shell plate, viz:- $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", but I shall be glad to learn if this is so.

The plan in question is returned herewith.
