In reply to your letter of the 3rd instant regarding the M.V. "LIZZIE & ANNIE", our report No.43132, we have to state that the sea connections of this vessel were examined at this Port in March 1932 (see Hul.report No.42657), and were not again examined on the occasion of the recent survey at this Port, as the vessel was not seen in dry dock. We might mention that the pumping arrangements and sea connections are those originally fitted in the vessel, the new engines being coupled up to them at this time, and the whole installation examined and tested as far as practicable, with the vessel afloat.
