Dear Sir,

The Owners of the motor ship "LIZZIE & ANNIE" of this Port, have ordered a new main engine for the vessel from Skandia-Verken, Aktiebolag, of Lysekil, which we understand will be sent to Hull in about three weeks.

This engine has not been built under special survey, but arrangements have been made for it to be examined here.

We are informed that the various scantlings of this engine are in accordance with our Rules, and shall be glad to know that the vessel may have a machinery record of L.M.C. when it has been ascertained that the engine is in accordance with our requirements and has been satisfactorily fitted on board.

We have asked the Swedish Surveyors to let us know what spare gear will be supplied that this may be submitted for approval.

The reason for this change of engines is that the Owners wish the ship to have a little more power.
