H. I have to acknowledge the receipt of your memorandum of the 12th instant enclosing a letter received by you from the Owners of the Motorship "LIZZIE & ANNIE".

The case has received consideration to-day, and I have to inform you that, provided the vessel be submitted to a General Examination in accordance with Circular No.1702 at an early date, and a satisfactory report as to her condition be received, the Committee will be agreeable to the 5th Special Survey No.1 being carried out sometime within the year of grace allowed by the Rules, i.e., by the end of July, 1939. I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly, and ascertain what arrangements they propose making for the requisite examination to take place.

It is noted that the Modified Survey of this vessel's Oil Engines is being carried out this week.
