nined in dry dock by a surveyor to your society since September,
7. We have however, obtained the ship's papers from Whitby
find that we hold a certificate form L.L.2 Lloyd's Register
Shipping - International Load Line Certificate No. 42622 which
tes that the ship was surveyed on the 9th December, 1958 at
1.

The certificate states that the normal survey becomes due on
e 12th September each year.

With regard to survey in dry dock, we took the matter up with
Agent at Whitby and he informed us that there are no dry dock
ilities at Whitby, and wondered if an external survey could be
e at low water at her berth when the vessel is high and dry on
e mud. We also note that the Screw Shaft survey becomes due at
e end of July next, and we would appreciate it if you would let us
ow the approximate cost of the two surveys.
