The Owners now state that owing to extremely adverse  
weather conditions which prevailed for the latter  
part of 1960 causing serious delay, the contract <sup>in Whitby Harbour</sup> is  
not now expected to be completed until May, 1961. It  
is concluded that further postponement of the Special  
Survey until May, 1961 (8 months beyond the year of  
grace), also machinery limit, is required.

The vessel is 83 years old and of iron construction.
