We have today received a letter from London re the extension of class for the above ship until early in 1961. As you know temporary repairs were carried out to a shell plate in June this year when a welded patch was fitted to the shell. It is considered that this repair is quite satisfactory whilst the ship is on her present station, i.e., working within the limits of Whitby Harbour, but that before proceeding to Hull early next year a general examination should be made at Whitby for the voyage to Hull to complete the Special Survey.
