Ltd., ^{+ address} and ascertain their intentions for completing the Special Survey.

To complete the Hull Survey for the notation SS (Dr) 10.59 the following matters require attention:-

- TO BE EXAMINED:-
- Fore peak space (dry), aft. peak tank; engine space and under engines; anchors and chain cable, mast and rigging, renewal Loadline Survey. Thickness of wood upper deck to be ascertained.
- TO BE TESTED:-
- Aft peak tank.

In addition ~~this~~ parts previously surveyed at Hull in October 1959 should be examined to ensure that the items are still in good condition.
