Repairs.

In September, 1894 the Hull Surveyors reported that this vessel's deck was thin in places, and it was then arranged with the Owner that the whole of the deck should be renewed.

The Hull Surveyors now report that this has been done to their satisfaction.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain classed QOAl, with record 6, 96 Hul. and notation of N.D. 96, as recommended.
