Gentlemen,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 31st ultimo enclosing an application for the assignment of freeboard to the Barge "LIZZIE & ANNIE", and with regard thereto I have to inform you that it will be necessary for this vessel to be placed in dry dock and surveyed internally and externally in accordance with the requirements of the Board of Trade Circular No. 1416, a copy of which is enclosed herewith. The rise of floor should also be measured while the vessel is in dry dock.

Particulars of the scantlings should be forwarded on report form 11d, the condition survey should be reported on form No. 8 and details of the hatchways &c., on the back of report form 11a.

The first entry report is also enclosed for your information.
