The remarks of the Chief Surveyor are desired on this Case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

The patent Asphalt (Dag's) which in Nov. 90 was found blistered & was then repaired with Portland cement should have been re-examined. The owner's Representative, in a letter dated Sept. 30th. 91 expresses his regret that, owing to want of time, this could not be done now.

It is submitted that the vessel appears worthy the favourable consideration of the Committee to remain as classed, viz: 100 A1 as recommended. At the same time it is further submitted, in view of the reported defective state of the Asphalt in Nov. 90, that an early opportunity should be afforded to have the Ballast tanks properly cleared for the examination of the same by the owner's Representative.
