## Part. Special Survey. No. 2

Vessel placed in dry dock bottom cleaned & coated found in good condition. Rubber examined & found satisfactory. The following remains to complete this survey:  
 That the holds, peaks, bunkers, bilges be cleared for examination.  
 The state of the frames, floors, beams, stringers, hatches & plating be ascertained.  
 That the loose fitting or hatches in bunkers be removed.  
 That the tanks be examined & tested as required by rule.  
 That the mast wedges be removed, & the state of the mast & spars be ascertained.  
 That the cables be ranged for inspection. That the pumps, sluices, & tunnel door be examined. That the general equipment be examined.

It is stated that this survey will be completed in August next at one of the ports in the West of England.
