Portion of Survey held, &c.

The S.S.No.2 which became due in June, 1894 was partly held in March last, and has now been further advanced; and to complete the same, the following requires to be done:— No.2 hold cleared, ceiling lifted, and examination made; ballast tank in same, and tank in E.&B.space cleared, examined, and tested: E.& B. bearers and other iron work in E.& B.space examined: mast, spare rigging, and general equipment examined and peak tanks tested.

The Surveyor reports that the main deck plates alongside the engine casing on starboard side and the lower plates in the coal ~~shoot~~ are defective. He recommends that they be renewed or repaired.

The Surveyor reports that the survey will be completed and repairs effected at Hamburg in 3 months time.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain classed ~~IOOAL~~ record of survey to be deferred until the S.S.No.2 is completed.
