Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "BAKUIN", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them reports from the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle and Cardiff on the alterations which have been recently effected to the vessel with a view to carrying and supplying liquid fuel to the boilers. The steamer is reported to have been temporarily fitted to burn coal until her arrival at Callao, where it is intended to remove the fire bars and fix the oil apparatus.

Under the circumstances, the Committee have continued the vessel's class with record of B.S.9,96; the notation of "Burning liquid fuel - Experimental" to be made when the oil fittings have been brought into use.

I shall feel obliged if you will kindly let me know when these changes are made.
