Dear Sirs,

I received your letter of the 6th. instant respecting the survey of your Steamer "BAKUIN", and having submitted the same to the Committee at their meeting today, I am directed to acquaint you that provided this vessel be thoroughly examined and the complete boiler survey be held within the next 6 months - when the vessel is in dry dock at Callao - by a competent Surveyor appointed by Lloyd's Agent at that port, and be satisfactorily reported upon, the Committee will be prepared, under the circumstances of the case, to agree to the postponement of the special survey No. 3 upon the distinct understanding that you will undertake to have this survey held within the next twelve months at a port where the Society has a Surveyor stationed.

Upon hearing from you that you accept this condition, and are giving the necessary instructions to your Agent at Callao to make arrangements for the survey in question to be held, I will communicate with Lloyd's Agents, with a view to the appointment of a Surveyor.
