Dear Sirs,

I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society have recently had under their consideration the case of the steamer "BAKUIN", which vessel is trading on the West Coast of South America. The vessel became due for Special Survey No.3 at the end of June 1898, and under the exceptional circumstances of the case the Owners have been informed that provided the vessel be thoroughly examined, and the complete survey of the boilers be carried out within the next six months, when the vessel is in dry dock at Callao, and be satisfactorily reported upon, the Committee will be prepared to agree to the postponement of the Special Survey No.3, provided the same be held within the next twelve months at a port where the Society has a Surveyor stationed.

The Owners have agreed to this condition, and I am therefore directed to ask you that, as the Society has no Surveyor stationed at Callao, you will be so good as to appoint a competent Surveyor to thoroughly examine the vessel and carry out the complete survey of the boilers when she is in dry dock at Callao. A sample report for the guidance of the Surveyor is enclosed herewith and forms for reporting the inspection in question are also forwarded. On the completion of the survey, I shall be obliged if you will kindly transmit these documents to this office.

In regard to the examination of the boilers, I beg to acquaint you that it will be necessary for the main and donkey boilers and their safety valves to be thoroughly examined and the safety valves to be adjusted to a safe working pressure not exceeding 150 and 75lb respectively.

The amount of the fees charged should be marked in the space

provided for that purpose on the report forms, and must be paid by the Owners or their representatives. In addition to the fee charged by the Surveyor for the actual Surveys, an office or registration fee of 10/- should be charged on behalf of this Society, and I shall be obliged if you will kindly collect that amount and forward the same to me with the report.
