Nature of Survey

S.S. No. 3 due 6.98

The S.S.No.3 became due in June 1898 and the year of grace expired in June last.


In May last the Owners stated that the steamer would in all probability be in Callao within the next six months, where she would have to be dry docked, and they would be glad to know if the Committee would allow the survey to be held while she was there.

In reply, the Owners were informed that provided the vessel were thoroughly examined, and the complete Boiler Survey held, within the next six months (when the vessel was in dry dock at Callao) by a competent Surveyor appointed by Lloyd's Agent at that port, and be satisfactorily reported upon, the Committee would be prepared, under the circumstances of the case, to agree to a postponement of the S.S.No.3 upon the distinct understanding that they would undertake to have the survey held within the next 12 months at a port where the Society has a Surveyor stationed.

Lloyd's Agent at Callao was accordingly written to and the necessary instructions forwarded respecting the survey required to be held.

These reports have now been forwarded to this Office by the Secretary of Lloyd's.

The main, fore-castle and long poop decks have been partly renewed and some minor repairs effected. The vessel has been examined in dry dock, the limbers lifted and the vessel generally examined and found in good condition.



It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed without record of survey, subject to the S.S.No.3 being held before the end of May next as approved by the Committee on the 16th May last.

The Owners should be informed accordingly
