Reverting to my letter of the 16th May last year and to subsequent correspondence respecting the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "**BAKUIN**", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them today a report of survey held at Callao on this vessel and her boilers upon the occasion of her visits there in September, November & January by Surveyors appointed for the purpose by Lloyd's Agent, and I am directed to say that in accordance with ~~the~~ intimation in my letter of the 16th May, the Committee have allowed the vessel's class to remain undisturbed subject to the Special Survey No.3 due in June 1898 being held before the end of May next.
