Dear Sirs,

Reverting to my letter of the 8th November last, and to previous correspondence between us respecting the Special Survey No.3 required by the Society's Rules on your steamer "BAKUIN", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case of this vessel again under consideration, upon the expiration of the period of six months for which they deferred the matter, and with regard thereto, I am directed to say that in view of the Special Survey in question not having been complied with, they regret they have no alternative but to expunge the vessel's class with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I may add that upon the receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyors upon the completion of the survey in question the vessel will be eligible to have her class re-instated in the Society's Register Book.
