REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR *Special Survey No 1 In part. Stated to have sustained heavy weather and to have grounded. Vessel now placed on the Pontoon, bottom examined, paint found chafed and abraded particularly from flat Reel Plate in fore body: now cleaned and coated. Repaired as noted below. Holds, upper cross bunker & tween deck bunker cleaned, cleaned & coated also peaks. Double bottom under Engines examined internally and found satisfactory, together with equipment generally. Repairs now done. Four ^{started} bolts of flat Reel Plate re-riveted, also several ^{found} rivets in fore body all now renewed. Damaged gig renewed & broken spring buffer to port wheel chain renewed. To complete S.S. No 1 the following remains to be done: Peak tank & double bottom in E&B space to test. Double bottom under boiler to examine internally, also lower bunkers to clear and examine with hand pumps sluices & water tight (Aovs).*
