Nature of Survey *ss no. 3* When due *2 05*

The S.S.No.3 became due in February 1905, and some damage through ice reported by the Newcastle Surveyors in March 1905 requires to be permanently repaired when the Special Survey is held.

The bottom of the vessel was examined in dry dock by the Newcastle Surveyors recently, and a proposal of the Owners to carry out the Special Survey at the end of April was approved.

The Owners now state that they find it impossible to carry out the survey at the end of next month, owing to the charterers of the vessel having exercised their option to take her for another voyage. The Owners will therefore be glad if the Committee will allow the survey to be postponed until the first week in June.

The Owners proposal is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
