

With reference to your letter of the 25th instant, we beg to advise you that the damage sustained in the collision at Bordeaux by this vessel was very slight, and will be repaired at the first opportunity on the Ship's return to the U. K.

We do not anticipate that the Steamer will require steaming out, as the damage is entirely in the way of the Engine Room and the side bunkers. We will, however, on the first occasion of her being steamed out, fit the extra stiffening as arranged with your Surveyor in the Tyne.
