GROUNDING.

This vessel is reported by the Hamburg Surveyors to have been examined as far as practicable afloat, ~~and by a Diver~~, after grounding, and so far as could be seen no damage appears to have been sustained. ~~The Surveyor however recommends that~~ All Petroleum tanks & tanks in way of engine boiler spaces sounded & found dry; but the tanks have not been examined internally.

~~It is submitted~~ The Surveyors recommends vessel to be placed in dry dock for further examination at first suitable opportunity.

It is submitted action be deferred, & the Owners asked to state when & where it will be suitable for the vessel to be dry docked for examination.
