With reference to the Second Special Survey No.2 of the steamer "BAKU STANDARD", which was partly held at Barry in June last, I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have today had before them a report from the Society's Surveyor at Gibraltar, from which it appears that two rudder pintles have been renewed, and I think it well to inform you that it is recommended that the rudder head (which is worn and grooved at the glands) and the pintles, braces, and other fittings, be further examined at the next dry docking.
