Scarcely whether any and, if so, what alteration is suggested to be made in the existing classification and notification of the vessel in the Register Book consequent upon this survey, or "to remain as classed and to have record of survey, 1.11, and the notations of ss No. 1-11 and pt ND 11, &c."

To continue as now classed, the above work is considered
labourious nature, but recommend that on the next
case of docking the rudder head, (which is worn & grooved at
all) pintles, braces & other fittings be thoroughly examined
& any repair if then required be carried out
