I beg to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society have had under consideration to-day the case of your S.S. "BAKU STANDARD", in which the 2nd Special Survey No. 2 became due so long ago as May 1914, and has not yet been completed. As you are aware, the vessel's class has been allowed by the Committee to remain undisturbed up to the present in view of the Steamer being in the employ of the Admiralty, but as it appears that she is at the present time undergoing repairs in the Tyne, the Committee consider that opportunity should now be taken to complete the Special Survey in all respects, and they will therefore be glad if you will take the matter up with the Admiralty so that arrangements may be made for this to be done.
