Dear Sirs,

H. I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Copenhagen reported last month that the 2nd Special Survey No.2 of the barque "PAMIR" had been advanced and that to complete the same the ceiling and steelwork in way of the ballast required to be examined and the standing rigging to be lifted and stripped.

The shell plating was drilled at Helsingfors in August, and the Owner has been informed that in view of the extended nature of the survey held at Copenhagen this survey will be accepted as a 2nd Special Survey No.3 when the above items have been dealt with.

The Owner states that the ceiling and steelwork in way of the ballast will be examined in Australia before loading and that the standing rigging will be dealt with at a home port next year.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will arrange for the case to receive attention.
