The WELLINGTON Surveyor reports (4.45) this 4 masted barque placed in floating dock, bottom coated, shell plating drilled where considered necessary, repairs to deck plating in way of galley and to minor items effected.
On account of heavy weather damage, 18 new sails supplied.

It is submitted the vessel is eligible to remain as classed with record of survey 4.45.
