With reference to your Report No.3704 on the "PAMIR" the Committee have deleted the notation of "Laid up - surveys overdue" but are withholding the posting of the docking date and tailshaft date until the outstanding fees in the case have been paid.

The latest information on this point is that the Landesbank und Girozentrale Schleswig-Holstein writing on the 24th ultimo state that the question of discharging the two accounts for the "PAMIR" and "PASSAT" amounting in all to DM.1,746.50 is still under consideration and they hope to give us a final answer at the earliest possible date.

The Classing Committee, when considering the report on the "PAMIR" suggested that help in achieving settlement might be forthcoming from the Bank's Agents, Messrs. Zersson & Co., and I shall be glad if you will negotiate with this firm on the basis that if the overdue accounts are not settled within a short time both vessels will be liable to loss of class.
