Dear Sir,

The receipt of Mr. Sheffer's letter of the 7th instant regarding the loss of the above ship has drawn attention to the fact that for some reason which we have been unable to establish, an endorsement prepared by Mr. Macmillan on the 3rd October last does not appear to have been acted upon.

About that time the Chairman wrote privately to the Owners and Mr. Cook addressed a semi-official letter to Mr. Sheffer. The case was subsequently submitted to the Committee for the assignment of a Casualty Notation on the 8th October and it rather seems that although the case received so much attention this particular endorsement must have been overlooked during circulation.

In any event it was the intention to refer to the forthcoming Formal Investigation and, in view of the fact that the ship was classed with this Society, and was submitted to Special Survey in 1956 followed by a docking survey at Hamburg in 1957, to ask if the Society's interests were likely to be involved.

Before, therefore, we write to the Owners as suggested in Hamburg letter of the 7th December would you be so good as to let me have any comments you may be in a position to make on this point.
