760' x 87'-6" x 60'-0" mld.

Would you be good enough to inform me by return whether you will be disposed to pass inch steel rivets in 20/20th shell plates where the rivets will be laid up by hand, viz: between the tank margin and upper deck sheerstrake; the overlaps being treble rivetted. I am aware that the rule provides for 1½" rivets for this thickness of plate, but on referring the matter to Mr. Stephenson he considers that inch rivets will make the better job where laid up by hand. The diameter of the rivets where hydraulic will be used we propose to make 1½" as per rule
