With reference to your remarks regarding the bending moment of the ship, I shall be glad if you will be so good as to supply details of the conditions under which the calculations for the bending moment have been made, such as the draft, displacement, height of wave, amount of coal, stores and water on board, etc., in order that the bending moment may be compared on the same basis with that estimated at this Office before the scantlings of the topsides are decided upon.
