CUNARD EXPRESS STEAMER No. 735.

Mr. Hunter has been looking through the notes of  
Interview with yourself and Clydebank representatives on the  
25, 26th & 27th August last and with reference to Clause  
"Watertight Bulkheads" he says that there should be but two  
bars connecting the longitudinal and athwartship bulkheads, and  
that their size should not be greater than  $3\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2} \times 12/20$ ths  
in lieu of four bars  $3\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2} \times 10/20$ th.

Also under the head of "Bulkhead Shell Liners" he  
wishes the liner on the caulking side of the bulkhead to be of  
half diamond shape, on account of the closeness of the rivetting,  
on the other side of the bulkhead being as shown in marginal  
sketch of the notes referred to.

Will you kindly take these deviations into consideration.
