Referring further to your letter of the 1st inst we shall be pleased to learn if we can punch the margin of the watertight bulkheads in lieu of drilling as previously arranged ~~as~~ now that you find that punching the holes an eighth of an inch less in diameter than required by the Rules and riming them out to full size makes as good, if not a better job than if the holes are drilled.
