Please note that we purpose increasing the thickness of the half diamonds at the lower orlop stringer where the stringer face bars are cut by the webs from 12/20ths to 16/20ths. We are doing this on account of the face bars being 15/20ths thick, and we think they will need a thicker connecting plate to attach them than that previously approved.
