Dear Mr Cornish,

Respecting the test pieces for experiments to determine the modulus of elasticity of high tensile steel and of ordinary mild steel, Messrs Spencer only intend taking two test pieces from one high tensile plate and two from one mild steel plate of same thickness, as indicated in your letter of 14th October. From your letter of the 15th inst it would seem that test pieces are required from both the $\frac{3}{4}$ " and 1" plates making with the corresponding mild steel plates eight test pieces in all instead of four as contemplated by Messrs Spencer. I shall be glad if you will let me know if the test pieces from the 1" plates will be sufficient.
