With reference to the case of the Cunard Express Steamer
No. 735 building by Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson,
Lim., I have to inform you that it is understood the Owners
desire the three bower anchors for this vessel to be 10, 10
and 9 tons in weight respectively, also to dispense with the
stream anchor, the kedge being retained, and to substitute
a steel wire hawser in lieu of the stream chain.

I have therefore to request that you will be so good as
to confer with the Builders with a view to the proposed
equipment of the vessel being in agreement with the Owners'
wishes before the matter receives the consideration of the
Committee.
