We have in hand 2 swivel pieces for the New Cunarder S.S. "~~Mauretania~~" "Mauretania" as per enclosed print to Admiralty Specification, & as these we suppose, will have to be included in the Cable Outfit & under Lloyds Statutory Conditions, we should be glad to hear at once (as the work is nearly completed), if you wish us to make any provisions in the manufacture for any tests you may wish to apply.

We might say that the swivel is equal to a tensile strain of about 250 tons & the links to about 220 tons without injury or any alteration in shape.

Please let us have any instructions you wish to give at once, as we do not wish to be delayed in completing the work.
