The Newcastle Surveyors should be requested to forward the necessary measurements and particulars as noted on a form 11C. and to show also thereon the depths from base line at top of outer thickness of flat-keel plate to top of upper deck beam at side at middle of length; (2) to top of wood sheathing on upper deck at side; (3) to top of wood sheathing on shelter deck at side
