FREEBOARD.- So that you may be fully informed, we beg to state that the Principal Officer of the Board of Trade at North Shields has requested us to send him a diagram showing the proposed grouping of weights and the consequent static stresses which would come upon this vessel with a freeboard of 23'-6" measured to the top of the shelter deck stringer at side and corresponding to a draught of 37'-3". We have accordingly forwarded the diagram to the Principal Officer and now beg to hand you a duplicate copy. We believe that the diagram will sufficiently explain itself, as we have added two tabulated statements, one of which illustrates the static stresses &c., when at a draught of 33'-6" and the other at the desired draught of 37'-3".

We also enclose a duplicate sketch showing the longitudinal view of the vessel, also height of sidelights and scuppers and other outlets, together with a detail sketch of one of the brass storm valves, which will illustrate
